Re: Student Achievement Awards 2019-20

We are truly delighted to be introducing a rewards structure, which will further enhance our culture of engagement and encouragement through the Positive Discipline system and will further promote students being rewarded for long-term exceptional behaviour, attendance and attitudes at The Morley Academy.

The Student Achievement Awards promote and reward exceptionally high standards of attendance, conduct and behaviour, strong attitudes to learning and recognise contributions made to the wider success of the academy, beyond lessons.

The Student Achievement Awards will begin in September 2019 and will apply to all students in Year 7 to Year 10. Students will need to achieve all of the criteria set out in one of the columns in order to achieve at that level. The three awards are:

- Award for Excellent Achievement;
- Award for Outstanding Achievement;
- Award for Exceptional Achievement.

Students who have successfully achieved the criteria for one of the awards will be invited to a celebration ceremony with parents/carers where they will receive an award/trophy to recognise their achievement.

In addition, depending on the award achieved, students will receive a reduction in the cost of the Positive Discipline rewards trip in 2020. For students who achieve at the highest level, Award for Exceptional Achievement, the rewards visit will be free of charge.

Enclosed in this letter is a copy of the criteria which sets out what students will need to do in order to achieve at each level. We will communicate with you throughout the course of the academic year detailing where your child currently stands in terms of the Student Achievement Awards and what they need to do to improve further.
